The Chalet was built in late 1988 in a European style. Our rooms provide King Size or Twin accommodation, all with en-suite, remote control television with in-house video and satellite available. We have a total of twenty six rooms. All rooms are well equipped with reverse cycle air-conditioning, and open on to a balcony. The Chalet Bedrooms have recently undergone a complete refurbishment. The Chalet has a delightful first class restaurant and guests have a wide choice of food. Meals are provided in this package (except in transit). Breakfast consists of a buffet and cooked selection, and a delicious buffet is served at night, morning tea is supplied while on tour at the Chalet. There is a coffee lounge, a cocktail lounge, also a guest lounge with open fire.

6 Day Itinerary

Day 1: Depart Port Melbourne Monday at 10.00am Morning from your club at Prot Melbourne and travel to Bright, stop for morning tea at Wallan. After a lunch stop at Eura we travel to Bright passing Benalla and Glenrowan and then via the Ovens Valley Highway. While on route we pass through the towns of Myrtleford and Porepunkah and onto Bright Chalet where you will settle in for five nights of great food and enjoyment (Bar will open & Dinner will be served on arrival).



Day 2: Bright is alive with Autumn colours with the backdrop of exotic trees ablaze in red & gold to provide a carpet of colours - and Autumn harvest heralding the change of seasons. After Breakfast we drive to Harrietville and visit Granny's Pantry and the historic Gold Settlement. We then visit Wandiligong: a 10 minute drive from Bright, this picturesque valley is classified a heritage town by the National Trust.



The Alpine park provides a setting for a pleasant picnic lunch, discover historic buildings and gold diggings and visit the largest apple orchard in the southern hemisphere. Back to Bright for lunch and a wander around the street of Bright maybe spend some time at the Bright Art Gallery.

Day 3: After Breakfast we have an early Start and depart the Chalet at 8.30 am for a visit to Mount Buffalo and the Historic Mount Buffalo Chalet for a fantastic View of the Ovens Valley where you will have morning tea. Then down to Myrtleford for a Lunch Stop. The Pumpkin Seed Factory in Myrtleford is the largest producer of pumpkin seed products and has a great Variety for tasting and sale.



Day 4: After Breakfast we depart the Chalet for the drive via historic town Chiltern where we stop for morning tea. We then travel onto the Border towns of Yarrawonga and



Mulwala and the banks of Lake Mulwala to board the P.S. Cumberoona for a lunch time cruise around the foreshore (lunch included). On disembarkation we spend some time around Yarrawonga and then drive onto Buller Wines a local winery for a sample of local vintages.



Day 5: This morning we Visit the snow Line Deer and Emu Farm: a most interesting place to visit, the talk on the deer and by-products of deer harvesting is very entertaining. Then on to Beechworth:- a beautiful and historic township, with old shops to wander around and find out more about Ned Kelly. The Lace Shop is a great place for the ladies to visit. The Beechworth Bakery:- an award winning attraction in Beechworth where everyone stops for lunch. The Rock Cavern:- a great display of precious and semi precious gem stones. Billson's Brewery :- this is a must, the largest collection of bottles in the Southern Hemisphere, Beer and spirits are brewed here also fine cordials are made and sold. Purchase some honey from the award winning Beechworth honey shop tastings also available. You can also visit Light Horse memorabilia section and museum. Mayday Hill s Beechworth's Historic Mental asylum which officially closed in 1996. After Beechworth we Visit Bonegilla Migrant Camp and Museum, this is where all migrants after the second world war and beyond were taken to assimilate into Australian Society.



Day 6: We Depart the Chalet at about 9.00 in the morning after a hearty breakfast to return to Port Melbourne, Just after Myrtleford we turn on-



to the old snow road and travel via Miliwa where we stop the Miliwa Cheese factory for a chance to purchase a variety of cheeses all made on site. We stop the Miliwa Bakery for morning Tea. We then travel to the Hume highway, lunch stop will be at the roadhouse at Euroa and then on to Melbourne to arrive at Port Melbourne at around 3.30pm.
